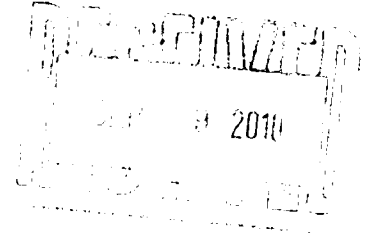

This letter is in response to your August 30, 2010 letter regarding the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Million Conservation Resource Group's (MCRG's) proposed Regional Watershed Supply Project in Wyoming and Colorado.
